

## Lonely Venice (DADGAD Tuning)

I've been lucky enough to play at the ADGPA festival in Italy a few times now and found myself wandering Venice one night. It's not a sad tune or title, just a memory of that sense when traveling alone. That night I sat listening to a beautiful lute in a courtyard when an odd tourist sat beside me and pointed out the sewer drain nearby. Still confused.

### Flicker (CGCGCD Tuning)

This tune popped out of my mandolin one night in a rough demo. Years later it took me long hours to unravel the melody. I never hoped to find a fiddler so expressive as Kierah Raymond to bring the tune to life. The title refers to those holiday weekend camp-fire nights.

### Black Water (CGDGCD Tuning)

The title says it all for this tune, bleak and gloomy. I nearly abandoned it until I found a nice key change near the end to give it the sense of a hopeful story. The guitar parts came out of exploring minor key ideas in this CGDGCD tuning. I was surprised by how readily this tuning embraced the heavy stuff.

### Northern Light (CGDGCD Tuning)

A sentimental tune about being a boat in the sun a long way from everything. I rather indulged myself with the new age keyboard and water sounds on this one. As a kid I used to like this sort of music lost in my own little world. This tune takes me back to that.

# Shallow Sea (DAAEAE Tuning)

The title track, named partly as a reference to an old Aussie favourite tune from the 80's (Short Note by Matt Finish). But partly too it is simply an image I like to bring to mind. The tune has a real bagpipe drone underneath. The trick to making this work was to overlay 3 separate bagpipe tracks to add the natural chorus effect. Written for the memories of Simon Nield and Katy Fox.

### Little Harbour (DAAEAE Tuning)

Named after a sign post while on holiday in Nova Scotia. Often I write ideas when watching a movie, and I forever associate the two. For the 120 minutes it took me to figure out the ascending B minor run, I was glued to the film Contact and will always think of Jodie Foster in space when I play this one.

### The Painted Hills (CGDGCD Tuning)

A sleepy lullaby tune written late in the night. It's a simple melody but explores all corners of the guitar neck and was challenging to record. For a few days I laboured over a flute melody before sanity returned and I realized that the melody was already there. The Painted Hills is a sweet title I grabbed when a friend told me about the so-named hills in Oregon.

# The Unknown Man (DADEAE Tuning)

A tune that looks back to my very early recording efforts with lots of open space. I find it a little icy, as it was written a time I was deeply absorbed in the title's great Australian mystery from 1948. A man, still unknown, was found dead on a beach in 1948, and left behind a trail of chilling clues still yet to be unraveled. Many, like myself, fell into the details of the case, trying their hand at a bit of code-breaking and image analysis on the hunt for clues. We never got anywhere with it.

### Evergreen (DADFAD Tuning)

A dark and broody minor tune that is the most difficult to play on the album. The title is a reference back to the tune Wintergreen from my Duck Shed album. This is one of those tunes written without any plan and just letting it unfold over several years.

### Dagger Woods (DAAEAE Tuning)

A tune of many twists and turns, this is one of those epics that take a few years to settle on. The song writing challenge was to find a way back somewhere that made sense. The brief moments of Jazz are probably a first in this bagpipe guitar tuning. Named after another road-trip street sign drive by in Nova Scotia.

### Rain Sparkles (CGCGCD Tuning)

The rain is world-class in Vancouver. They're serious about it over here. By March you've been soaked for 5 relentless months and sparkly droplets on the bus window are not usually met with open arms. Until a wonderful new friend came along and texted me one morning along these lines. The theme of the tune is, obviously, rain, with a big storm in the middle and then the kind of rain that you sit on the porch watching with a glass of wine. One of the most difficult unes to play and record.

# Mildred's Red Umbrella (DADGAD Tuning)

The first tune I ever wrote on a mandolin. This one evolved over many jam sessions with friends, kitchen sessions in Ireland and a few folk camps. Mildred is the name of my mandolin, and red umbrellas are just cool. The tune took a new twist when Kierah Raymond got hold of it and added enough flair to render my mandolin part unnecessary.
